37 new works added to PM World Library in December

PM World Collection grows to 5,276 project management articles, papers & other works by 2,058 authors in 90+ countries

19 December 2024 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 37 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 58 authors in 17 different countries were published in the December 2024 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the [PM World Collection](#) to 5,276 original works by 2,058 different authors located around the world. The seven series articles by our regular contributors are also broadly applicable to many projects and industries. Contents of those categories alone contribute significantly to the global PM body of knowledge this month.”
