30 new works added to PM World Library in January

PM World Collection grows to 5,307 project management articles, papers & other works by 2,072 authors in 90+ countries

13 January 2025 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 30 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 43 authors in 15 different countries were published in the January 2025 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the [PM World Collection](#) to 5,307 original works by 2,072 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by 30-40 new works from many different authors; of the 43 authors this month, 14 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, “Many readers will notice that a majority of works published in the PMWJ each month are authored by returning authors. I want to thank those authors who show not only loyalty to the journal but are also demonstrating some value gained from publishing with us. Clearly both the number and range of both authors and readers have grown over the years. So as long as we keep processes simple and continue to give authors full visibility and credit for their work, these trends should continue.”

New works by 29 authors already included in the library were also added.

“Of course, new authors are more than welcome every month, and this edition is no different,” Pells adds. “I also appreciate the professors who bring their colleagues and graduate students to publish research in the PMWJ. And I want to personally thank Massimo Pirozzi in Rome for bringing his team of younger co-authors again this month in a powerful new paper on a highly relevant topic – communication with stakeholders in this emerging AI-powered world.”
