37 new works added to PM World Library

PM World Collection grows to 5,415 project management articles, papers & other works by 2,096 authors in 90+ countries

15 April 2025 – Dallas, London, Sydney – PM World has announced that 37 new articles, papers and other original works about program and project management have been added to the PM World Library (PMWL) this month. These contributions by 39 authors in 20 different countries were published in the April 2025 edition of the *PM World Journal* (PMWJ) at <https://pmworldjournal.com/>. The new additions bring the total in the [PM World Collection](#) to 5,415 original works by 2,096 different authors located around the world. The collection is growing each month by 30-40 new works from many different authors; of the 39 authors this month 7 were new to the journal and library. According to PMWJ Managing Editor David Pells, “The four letters to the editor are a highlight this month; it’s always interesting to read feedback or unexpected comments from readers and authors. The two interviews were again unique, and the 11 featured papers really helped fill this edition with well researched and relevant content.”

New authors this month include: Adam Boddison (UK), Salam Jaroshi (Libya), Brian McGlynn (Australia), Lillian Muyunda (Zambia), Thomas Phiri (Zambia), Shankar Sankaran (Australia) and Alina Uugwanga (Namibia). New works by 32 authors already included in the library were also added.

“But the articles and reports this month may offer the most relevant works for professional readers,” Pells adds. “The six series articles, the advisory article by Yogi Schulz in Calgary, the five significant commentary articles and the four reports are all by very well-respected PM experts and authorities in their respective fields and locations. I am always honored to publish their works in the journal; this month is absolutely no exception.”
