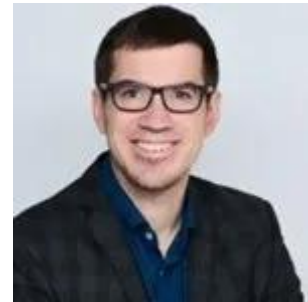

Sebastian Wieschowski appointed International Correspondent for PMWJ in Germany

Experienced journalist joins global correspondents team for PM World Journal and Library

In September 2024, he joined the German Project Management Association (GPM), the national member association of the International Project Management Association (IPMA). Working in marketing and public relations, he is responsible for developing GPM's media relations and serves on the editorial board of PM Aktuell, a quarterly magazine distributed to more than 6,500 GPM members as well as external stakeholders.

Alongside his professional career, Sebastian Wieschowski is also active as a freelance author in his lifelong passion, numismatics. He writes for both German- and English-language specialist publications, and his work has been recognized three times by the Numismatic Literary Guild, a writers' association based in the USA.
