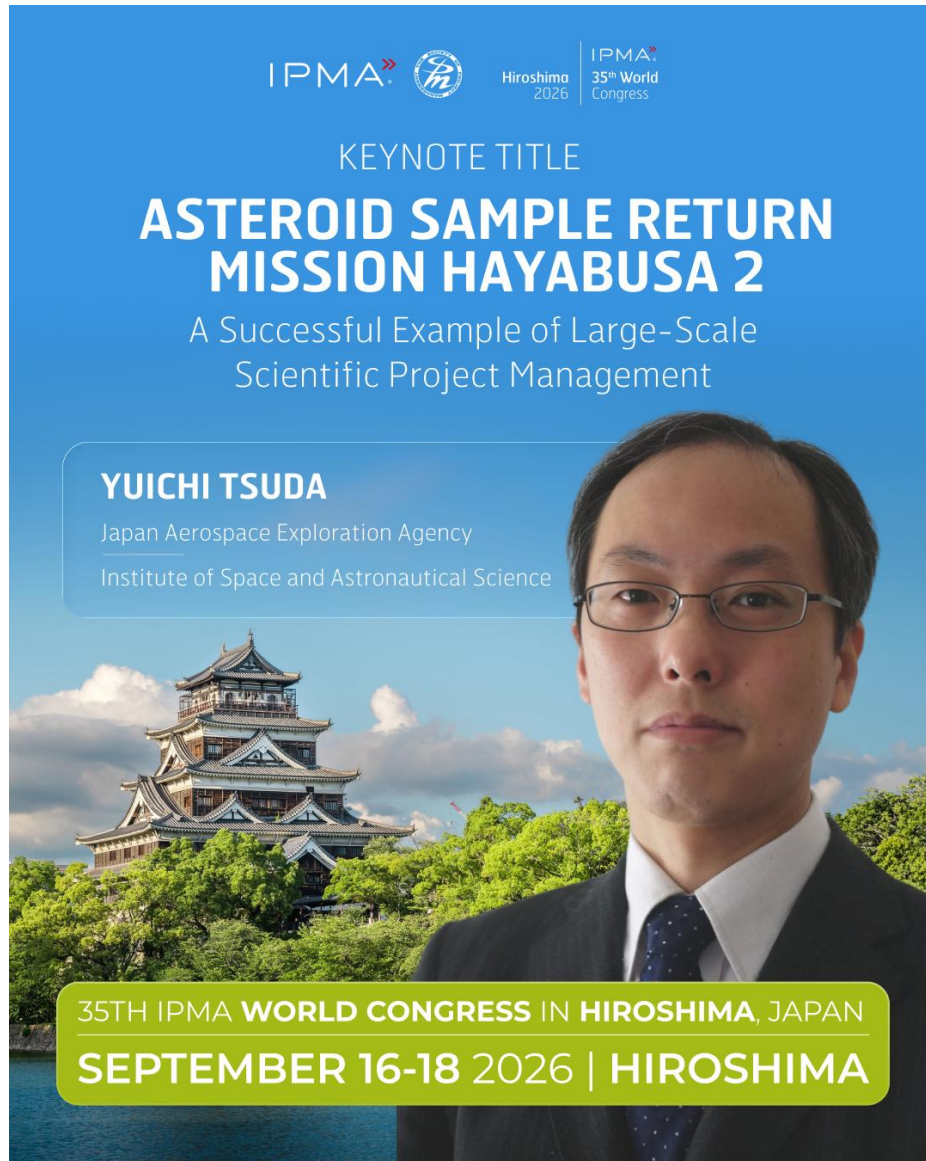

Second Keynote Speaker Announced for the 35th IPMA World Congress

The keynote programme for the 35th IPMA World Congress continues to grow with the announcement of another distinguished speaker.

Yuichi Tsuda from the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) / Institute of Space and Astronautical Science will deliver a keynote presentation titled **"Asteroid Sample Return Mission Hayabusa2 – A Successful Example of Large-Scale Scientific Project Management."**

Drawing on his experience leading one of the world's most ambitious space exploration missions, Mr. Tsuda will demonstrate how project management principles were applied to successfully plan, coordinate, and execute the Hayabusa2 asteroid sample return mission. His presentation will highlight the importance of strategic planning, international collaboration, risk management, and innovation in delivering highly complex scientific projects.

Attendees will gain valuable insights into managing large-scale, technology-driven initiatives and discover how lessons learned from space exploration can be applied across industries to improve project outcomes.

With the addition of Mr. Tsuda, the Congress further strengthens its programme under the theme **"Delivering Peace: Project Management for a Sustainable World."**
