Rajat has authored 14 books and serves on the editorial boards of several international journals such as Management Consulting Journal and is the Chief Editor of International Journal of Project & Technology Management. He is a Fellow of Institution of Engineers (India), Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers, Institute of Management Consultants of India, World Academy of Productivity Sciences, Canada and Academic Fellow of International Council of Management Consulting Institute (ICMCI) USA.

He has served as a member of the Research Management Board of the International Project Management Association (IPMA), Switzerland and was also editor of the Research Management Board's (RMB) journal for IPMA. He served as Team Leader and Jury member for the International Project Excellence Award of IPMA. He has supervised 10 PhD theses and 76 Masters theses in the areas of Strategic Management, Supply Chain, Logistics Management, and Project Management.

Prof Baisya is the President of Project & Technology Management Foundation (www.ptmfonline.com) and Vice President of the Asia Pacific Federation of Project Management (www.apfpm.net). He is also Chairman of Strategic Consulting Group Pvt Ltd, based in India.
